Between 2008 and 2015 she was a member of the Congress of Deputies, in the IX and X legislatures. Likewise, in 2015 she was part of the Government of Aragon as Councillor for Innovation, Research and University, and was also a member of the regional parliament from 2015 to 2019. In 2019 she was the PSOE candidate for the municipal elections in Zaragoza, being the most voted force. Subsequently, she served as spokesperson for the socialist group in the City Council until February 2020 when she was appointed Government Delegate, a position she held until July 2021.

In 2021 she is appointed Minister of Minister for Education and Vocational Training and Sports. Currently also spokesperson of the Spanish Government.
